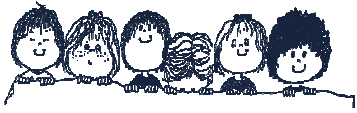

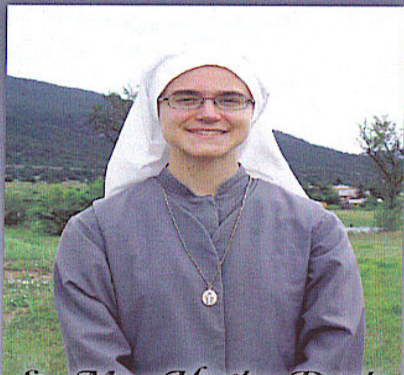

What were some of the blessings you encountered in Apostolic Novitiate?
 One of the greatest blessings of my apostolic novitiate was getting to serve God's little ones. I helped in the 2-5 year old class at Our Lady's Montessori School in Kansas City. I was actually quite intimidated at first because I had never worked with such young children before, but it was truly God's gift to me. The kids brought me so much joy and were constantly teaching me. God reveals the Kingdom through His little ones because there is such a beautiful simplicity about children. As adults, we tend to get caught up in life and take ourselves too seriously. Children find joy in the smallest things and have such a sense of awe at the beauty of the world around them. I loved to see them marvel with great delight at something so simple as a flower, a leaf, or a bug. These things adults so often overlook because they have become so ordinary, but to a child the world is so new that they really recognize how extraordinary and beautiful it is. 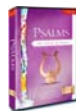
