At the end of this weekend Masses, I made the announcement that the proposed sale of our Green Street properties to the Town of Brownsburg has fallen through. Needless to say I as well as the members of the Pastoral Council and the Planning Committee are disappointed as much work has gone into finalizing this deal. I hope you will take the time to read my letter located elsewhere in this bulletin that describes in more detail the efforts gone into this effort.

On another note as negotiations were progressing the Planning Committee realized that we would need some temporary office space for the parish staff for several years. So at their recommendation and with the approval of the Pastoral Council we purchased a home in the Lake Ridge subdivision to use as a rectory for Fr. John and I to live so we could convert the Twin Street rectory to office space. We moved into the new rectory in mid-December (thanks for all who helped us move) and are enjoying it. Fr. John is grateful that the garage is big enough for him to park inside. I am grateful for a larger bedroom so I am not tripping over things. We both are grateful that the kitchen and dining area are large enough to host dinners (Fr. John has already hosted eight of his siblings for dinner). As we move forward in the process of the relocation of the parish to the new property, it is good to have the availability of the Twin Street house for our future plans. Let's continue as a parish to pray to God for His guidance as we endeavor to complete our relocation efforts. God Bless, Fr. Joe

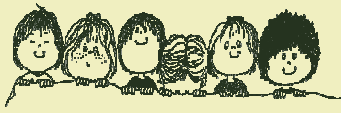

Annual Clothing Drive

Annual clothing drive to benefit **Sheltering Wings** from 12:00 to 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, February 26.

Sheltering Wings is an emergency housing system in Danville that gives shelter to women and children who are victims of domestic violence. The clothing we collect does not go directly to the shelter, they can't afford to store hundreds of bags of clothing in their building. Therefore, we have teamed up with Goodwill Industries. For every bag of clothing we collect, Goodwill will give Sheltering Wings a \$5 voucher to a local Goodwill store. This voucher allows the women at the shelter to get the clothes they need and lets the women shop for their personal tastes.

All types of clothing can be included; men's, women's, and children's, including, belts, purses, and shoes. Before we send the clothing to Goodwill, we look through the bags and pull out any new or gently used items to meet immediate needs at the shelter. We also set aside infant clothing for Birthline and men's clothing for Beggars for the Poor and the Cathedral Soup Kitchen, and men's interview suits for Danny's Closet of Hope.

Dear St. Malachy Parish Family :

This letter has been prepared for me by the Planning Committee to provide our parish family an update on the “Growing in Faith, Building in Hope” parish campus relocation efforts.

In September 1999, the St. Malachy Parish Planning Committee was formed. The purpose of the Planning Committee, as stated in the by-laws: “... *is to work collaboratively with the pastoral council, commissions, committees, and parish related organizations in areas of planning.*” The initial task undertaken by the Planning Committee was to establish a master plan for the Parish. The result of the master plan was to relocate the St. Malachy Parish campus from the Green Street location to our new location. The initial phase of the relocation culminated in December 2008 with the dedication of the new church.

In early 2010, I, as pastor, established a new Planning Committee. As with the initial Committee, the new Planning Committee members included representatives from all ministries of our parish. The first task of the Committee was the discussion of the continued relocation efforts of the parish campus. The recommendation to the Pastoral Council was to obtain Archdiocesan approval to begin a new capital campaign with the goal of the campaign to sell our current property on Green Street and complete the relocation of our parish campus. The funds from the capital campaign and sale of our Green Street property would also pay the remaining \$3 million of debt owed to the Archdiocese from the building of our church. The Archdiocese authorized St. Malachy to move forward with the new campaign and relocation plan.

In the fall of 2010, we were approached by two parties interested in purchasing the Green Street property. The Planning Committee welcomed each inquiry with prompt consideration and responsiveness. One interested party was the Town of Brownsburg. The Town expressed strong interest in acquiring the Green Street property for Parks Department development and initiatives.

During calendar year 2011, both the Town and St. Malachy worked together in good faith to negotiate terms toward a formal Purchase-Sale Agreement. Both St. Malachy Parish and the Town of Brownsburg have formal and legal obligations and protocols to sell or purchase property. These checks and balances are put in place by both the Archdiocese and the Town to ensure adequate communication and consideration occurs prior to purchase or sale. However, those same controls require time to navigate and manage. Even though the Planning Committee, Finance Committee, and Pastoral Council all worked in tandem with a high degree of urgency, negotiations with the Town spanned over a full year. Ultimately, the Town concluded it was unable to come to agreement on certain Purchase-Sale Agreement terms. These terms were being requested by St. Malachy to ensure that we would be able to enforce completion of the full purchase and sale of the Green Street property.

In lieu of the Town’s decision to terminate discussions to purchase the Green Street property, the Planning Committee recommended the parish list the property with a commercial real estate broker. Further, the Committee recommended beginning new discussions with the Archdiocese on the timing and logistics associated with the next capital campaign and relocation. These recommendations were approved by the Pastoral Council and ratified by me.
