I write this column for the Sunday when we recall the Baptism of Jesus. The effects of the Sacrament of Baptism include: washing away the punishment of Original Sin, offering the gift of eternal life, and incorporating one into the body of Christ. So it begs the question why was Jesus baptized? He was the Son of God, so He was not under the punishment of Original Sin as He could NOT sin. He was already enjoying eternal life in heaven. And of course He is Christ in whose body we are incorporated, so why was HE baptized? Matthew's account of Jesus' baptism gives us the answer. John the Baptist expressed his reluctance to baptize Him, and Jesus responded to John, "Allow it now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness." In other words Jesus was submitting to God's plan of salvation to save the human family. He became one of us in all things but sin, but through the action of baptism He is now identified with the sinners He came to save. Please join me in thanking Jesus for the Sacrament of Baptism, but most of all for His willingness to follow God's will and thus saving us all.

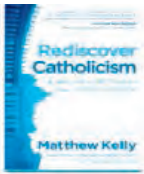
